## Price's Subdivision Wastewater Servicing and Drainage Improvements Project Information Newsletter #1

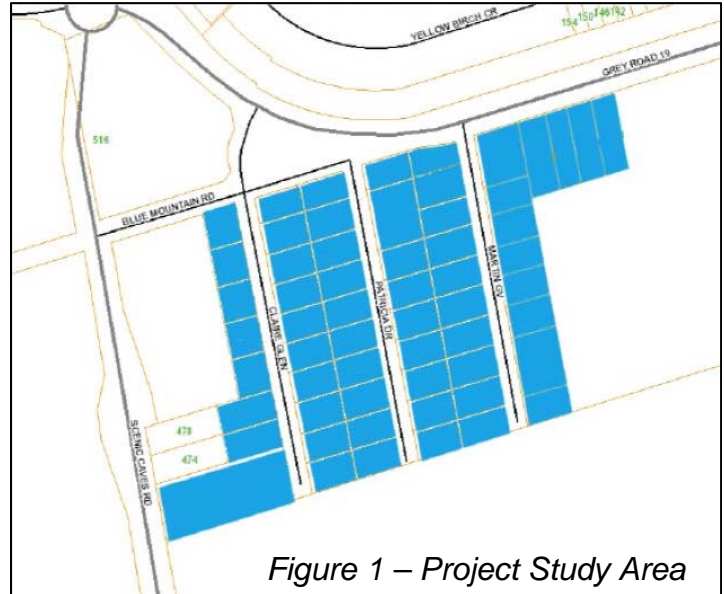
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Dear Resident:

The Town of The Blue Mountains is initiating an investigation into sanitary servicing options and drainage improvements for the Price's Subdivision to address the servicing needs of the Subdivision and improve existing stormwater conveyance deficiencies within the project study area (see **Figure 1**).

The purpose of this project will be to determine technical, financial, and environmental viability of drainage, stormwater management, and wastewater servicing solutions for the Price's Subdivision including the evaluation of previously identified and new innovative servicing strategies.

Preferred servicing strategies for the project area will be identified and the findings of the project will be presented and summarized at a Public Information Centre (PIC).

Please be advised that during the course of the project, you may see surveyors in the area, Geotechnical personnel drilling holes, as well as other activities involved in the investigation.

Public Consultation is vital to the success of this project. We want to ensure that anyone interested in this project has the opportunity to provide input. Therefore, various forms of public consultation will take place over the course of this project to receive public input and comments.

The Public Information Centre (PIC) will be held on both a Thursday night and a Saturday morning to present alternative servicing strategies and receive public input.

Notice of the PIC will be published in advance of the meetings in September. Subsequent project update newsletters and notices will also be emailed to residents requesting notification and posted on the Town's website (<http://www.thebluemountains.ca/prices-subdivision.cfm>) for the project to keep the public informed as the project progresses.

Residents and interested parties are encouraged to regularly visit this website to find out more about the project and to provide input and feedback on the project.

Comments and information regarding this project are being collected in accordance with the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act.
