Subject: Request to Waive Tent Permit Fee

Dear Troy:

Further to our previous discussions and E-mails, I am helping Home Horizon raise funds for a home for homeless youth on Campbell Street in Collingwood. After receiving my lead donation, they named the building after my dear wife Barbara. I am now helping Home Horizon raise the rest of the money required for the building. We need to raise \$850,000, and thanks to generous donors we are about half way there. The Home Horizon Barbara Weider House accommodates 7-10 young people, age 18-28, who have been rendered homeless by family or personal problems. They get counselling and transitional shelter at the residence and office.

On August 27th I am hosting a garden party at my home on Gord Canning Drive with a view to raising awareness of Home Horizon and the project, and we hope to raise \$20,000. We have rented a tent and there is a fee of \$250 that had to be included with the application to the Town. I am hoping that in view of the need for transitional housing and support program in the Georgian Triangle area, the Town might consider waiving the customary \$250 fee.

Attached is information about the event. We have invited Mayor McKean to be a special guest at no charge.

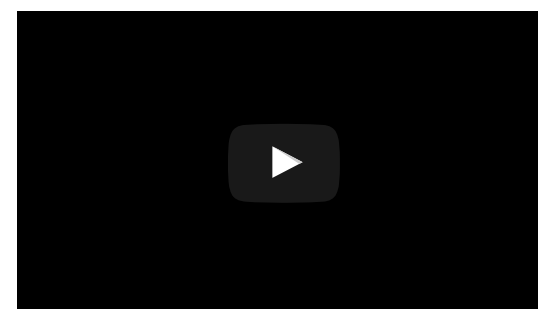
