I wanted to personally thank you for your guidance in this matter. This email is to be brought to attention of the Mayor of the Town of Blue Mountains and to the Council of the Town of Blue Mountains.

I am requesting to address the Council and Mayor in this matter

On January 19, 2017 I contacted Luc Prouix Municipal Licensing officer of the Town of Blue Mountains to complete the process STA License. I was issued my license on Feb 22 2017. I was aware that council was in the process of meeting to help reduce the fee, when I spoke to Luc he personally advised me that unfortunately the council came back with a denial to reduce the fee amount. At that time I had two other new units I had completed purchase and was in the process of a cosmetic renovation in both so not to waste time I completed STA License for all three units. Issue I have is two units would not be rented for some time after and so I was aware I would of waited and completed the Lic prior to beginning rental program of these units. The By_law change took in effect Feb 13, 2017, which is in between, when I applied and when it was issued and I would of waited the extra 2 weeks for the first unit and not rented if I was aware to save \$1500.00 or at least had the opportunity to save this amount.

I am requesting a refund or credit, as I just purchased another condo in Blue Mountains and will be needing another STA License, so \$1500 credit can be used towards on new one.

I also as a business owner with numerous corporations and over 22 years in business, I have a few suggestions that may help with the complete STA License process for both the town and the owners.
