THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF THE BLUE MOUNTAINS

BY-LAW NO. 2017 –

Being a By-law to amend By-law No. 2008-92, a by-law to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers;

WHEREAS Section 15 of the *Police Services Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.15, enables a municipal council to appoint persons to enforce by-laws of the municipality and indicates municipal law enforcement officers are peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws;

AND WHEREAS Section 11 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, authorizes the council of a local municipality to enact by-laws respecting matters within its sphere of jurisdiction and refers to municipal law enforcement officers;

AND WHEREAS the *Provincial Offences Act*, R.R.O. 1990, Chapter P.33, indicates that a Provincial Offences Officer means a municipal law enforcement officer referred to in Section 101(4) of the *Municipal Act*;

AND WHEREAS the *Building Code Act* indicates that an officer means a property standards officer who has been assigned the responsibility of administering and enforcing by-laws passed under section 15.1 of the Act;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the Town of The Blue Mountains deems it expedient to enact a By-law to appoint Chris Raynsford and Connor O'Hara as Municipal Law Enforcement Officers so as to enforce the by-laws of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE Council of the Corporation of the Town of The Blue Mountains does hereby enact as follows:

1. Chris Raynsford and Connor O'Hara are hereby appointed as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officers so as to enforce the by-laws of the municipality;

AND FURTHER that this By-law shall come into force and take effect upon the enactment thereof.
