

The Town of The Blue Mountains Waste Collection Guide 2019



Weekly Service Curbside Collection starts at 7:00am.
Please sort your waste accordingly.

Blue Container

The following items are blue box items. Glass bottles, plastic ice cream containers, plastic yogurt containers, empty condiment bottles, plastic food containers with recycling symbols 1 to 7 on them, tinfoil and aluminum trays, coffee cup lids, cans, pop cans, empty aerosol containers and empty paint cans.

If your Blue Box is full, clear bags can be used.

Grey Container

The Grey Bin is designated for paper products. The following items are grey box items. Paper products such as cereal boxes, milk containers, juice containers, newspaper, magazines, cardboard tubes such as paper towel and toilet paper rolls, paper cups, and soft cover books.

Cardboard boxes must be flatted into bundles no larger than 61 centimeters by 46 centimetres by 15 centimetres. Always remove contents such as trash or Styrofoam.

If your Grey Box is full, clear bags can be used.

Green Container

The Green Bin is designated for organics. A certified compostable liner is required. The following items are Green Bin items. Waste from fruit and vegetables, eggs, bread, tea bags, coffee and coffee filters, paper napkins and paper plates, scraps of chicken, meat and fish. The following is a list of items that are not to be placed in the green bin. Diapers and personal hygiene products, plastic, glass, metal, Styrofoam, cigarette butts and ashes, soil, rocks, bricks, plastic bags, elastic, textiles, waxed paper, other non-compostable waste, pet waste and yard waste.

Garbage

There is a two bag limit for curbside garbage collection. The second bag must be tagged. Tags are \$2.00 and can be purchased at Foodland, Hindles Hardware, Home Hardware, Circle K Craigleith and Thornbury, Ravenna Country Market, Tasty Market, Town Hall, L.E. Shore Library, Craigleith Heritage Depot and the Waste Disposal Site. Bags and Cans are limited to 18 kilograms. Cans must have side handles and is limited to 84 centimeters in height by 56 centimeters in diameter. Bags are limited to 76 centimetres by 97 centimeters in size.

Oversized and bulky construction and demolition debris will not be collected. The following items go into the garbage. Styrofoam, plastic utensils, diapers, plastic bags and film, durable goods, pet waste and litter, non-fluorescent light bulbs.

Seasonal Curbside Service Collection

Spring and Fall Curbside Yard Waste Collection

Maximum 10 containers or bags per week. The dates for this collection are May 6 to 30 and October 28 to November 21, 2019 on your regular day of collection. Bags and container size is 89 centimeters by 41 centimeters. No plastic bags allowed.

Battery Collection

For curbside, place batteries in battery bags on top of your blue box from September 2 to 26, 2019. For condos, place batteries in battery bag and place inside designated pail in central waste area from September 2 to 26, 2019.

Curbside Christmas Tree Collection

January 6 to 10, 2020 on your day of waste collection. No plastic bags and no decorations allowed.

Solid Waste Disposal Site, Household Hazardous Waste Depot, Holiday Collection

The Solid Waste Disposal Site

The Solid Waste Disposal Site will accept most waste, even many items not acceptable for curbside pickup. For information on waste acceptance and sorting see attendant on duty.

The hours of the Waste Disposal Site are Tuesday from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm, Thursday from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm and Saturday - 8:00 am to Noon. Closed on Boxing Day 2019.

The Waste Disposal Site accepts cash, cheque or interac. Minimum site use \$6.00. Sorted waste is \$130 a tonne, unsorted waste \$260 a tonne, clean wood, metals commercial brush, concrete are \$65 a tonne, freon items are \$15 a unit. There is no charge for recyclables, e-waste, tires, residential yard waste, and household hazardous waste

Household Hazardous Waste Depot

The Depot is open seasonally and will accept most household hazardous waste such as paint, used oil, cleaners, solvents, batteries, CFL bulbs, pesticides and more.

The Household Hazardous Waste Depot is open May 2 to September 28, 2019 on Tuesday and Thursday from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm and Saturday 8:00 am to noon.

Holiday Collection

Christmas Day, Wednesday, December 25, 2019 and New Year's Day, Wednesday, January 1, 2020 waste collection will not occur and collection will be delayed by one day for the remainder of the week. All other holiday and statutory days will be collected on the regular day of collection.
