C. Staff Reports

C.1 Detachment Commander's Report (verbal)

Sergeant Chris Maecker reviewed the 2018 Detachment Commander's Report for the 3rd Quarter covering areas of staff hours to conduct R.I.D.E. programs, along with officers patrolling on foot, bicycle, ATV and marine patrol.

Sergeant Maecker advised that Provincial Constable Ryan Lear has wrapped up the marine patrol for the season but is now focusing on a project with Ministry of Natural Resources for the upcoming hunting season and follow-up from complaint calls received regarding the Loree Forest.

Mayor McKean suggested to have signage posted advising the ATV riders that The Blue Mountains does not allow ATV's on roadways.

Inspector Mary Shannon advised that it is the responsibility of the rider/operator to do a quick research to know which municipalities allow or prohibit ATV's.

Sergeant Maecker noted that the detachment will be enhancing the bicycle hours/commitments in the summer of 2019. Chair Martin Mazza questioned if there were any particular areas in The Blue Mountains that are being considered for enhancement. Sergeant Maecker advised the areas would be the Village at Blue, Trails and Harbour, noting that the officers on patrol have received positive feedback from the residents.

Sergeant Maecker reviewed with the Board the current staffing compliment, number of calls received by the Mental Health Response Unit, the schedule change for officers which is ongoing, continued engagement with the Collingwood Cycling Club, composition of the auxiliary unit, break and enters, missing person investigation and a sexual assault investigation.

Inspector Mary Shannon noted that shift schedule for officers is currently being reviewed with Chief DeMarco, to include staggered shifts, where in the past, this was volunteered before by the officers, but will now be included on their schedules.

Sergeant Maecker noted that the Town of Shelburne decided to “opt out” following the Town of Markham’s model to prohibit the sale of Cannabis in private retail stores.
