We noticed on the Committee of the Whole agenda for Sept.16 meeting that town staff recommend approval of above. This is news to us. Although our e-mail address has been on town list since its inception. We wrote an objection e-mail last January and fail to see why we did not get a copy of your PDS report as our neighbour did. We await your comments on this matter. We are longtime permanent full time owner residents at Campbell Crescent.

We are still objecting to approval of the rezoning as you state that Mr. Stepanovic is using this address on his driver's licence - health cards don't count as they do not have an address. Any person with multiple homes can use any of the addresses he chooses. To prove 116 Campbell Crescent is his principal residence we need to have more information, for example children registered at local schools, local doctor, dentist, etc.

Our main objection is that he will be absent while his guests are on the premises, like an STA which is no longer permitted in our R2 area. Our other objection is that if this application is approved other people will apply for the same consideration on this Crescent.
